

## City of Kingman Utility Emergency Payment Plan

In order to assist customers impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic, the City is offering all residential and commercial customers an emergency payment plan (EPP). The EPP will work as follows:

- 1. Interested customers must complete this form and return it to City Hall to enroll in the EPP. If a customer has more than one account, an application must be completed for each separate account.
- 2. Applications for the EPP will be accepted from May 18, 2020, to May 29, 2020.
- 3. The customer's balance due as of the date of application will be divided into seven (7) equal amounts to determine the EPP payment. The EPP payments will start in June, 2020, and end in December, 2020. To get your accurate past due amount, please contact City Hall at (620) 532-3111.
- 4. The EPP payment will be due each month along with the customer's regular monthly bill.
- 5. As part of the EPP, customers must pay their regular monthly bill by the 10th day of the month to remain eligible for the EPP. The extra EPP payment will be due by the 25th day of the month. Should one of these days fall on a holiday or weekend, the due date will be the next business day.
- 6. If a customer does not pay on time or misses any payment, this EPP Agreement will be terminated and the account will be subject to disconnect under normal procedures. If disconnected, all past due amounts and fees must be paid to reconnect services.
