

### **YOUTH CORE MENTORING 2020-2021**

So far, this school has made 25 matches! That is AMAZING! I have some phenomenal teachers and counselors helping me get these kids matched. Also, a big shout out to Miss Annistan Henning who is helping me get the KHS mentors matched since getting into the school this year is hard due to COVID. Another big shout out to Jill Albright for taking our picture!

This year Kingman Youth Core Mentoring is running a mentor program in Kingman HS, Kingman MS, Kingman Elementary, St. Pat's Elementary, Cunningham K-12, AND Greensburg K-12! Even though COVID has interrupted us, it has not stopped us from doing what is important and that is mentoring our younger generation.



### **CORE COMMUNITY PROGRAM**

I would like to thank our community for the tremendous support of our Community Core Program, formerly called Circles. We started our first class April 2019 to help community members living in poverty. Due to Covid-19, we were unable to start our second class in April 2020 as we had planned. However, we started meeting in person on June 28, 2020 with a new class. We are also involved in phase 2 with the original class. These two classes meet every Monday evening at the Kingman Church of Christ. We are a 501c3 organization under the auspices of Youth Core Ministries located in Greensburg, KS. Youth Core Mentoring in Kingman is a separate organization, also under YCM.

Each week, our evening begins with supper at 5:30 for the entire family. Suppers are provided by volunteers each week. We have more than 12 groups who volunteer to prepare and serve 40-50 individuals each week. These groups represent a cross section of our community. They are made up of business people, church groups, civic organizations, and interested individuals. These meals are a highlight of the evening and are appreciated very much. If you would be interested in volunteering to provide a meal, please contact us. We can make arrangements for you to cook the meal, we can pick it up and we serve it. However, most of our groups cook and serve themselves. We are currently working to fill our meal calendar for the remaining Monday nights of 2020.

Core provides childcare each week for our families. We have 5 dedicated volunteers that take turns teaching and supervising the children once a month. These volunteers provide a short Bible lesson, crafts, and supervised play activities. They are assisted by teenage volunteers. The children of our families look forward to this.

After supper the children go to childcare and adult leaders begin their classes. Our facilitator leading the phase 1 class is Darrell Decker. He prepares lessons using material from a book titled "Getting Ahead in a Just-Gettin'-By World: Building Your Resources for a Better Life." The class is based on the work and research of Ruby Payne. Our phase 2 class is being led by Katy Girard. They are studying about improving their emotional health.

### **CORE COMMUNITY PROGRAM (CONT.)**

Amanda Naillieux, coach for the program is responsible for working and counseling with each leader and their family. This important part of our program gives our leaders someone to consult with on situations that arise in their daily lives. She helps them find the resources that they need.

Our fourth employee is Sharon James who is in charge of fund raising. We receive all of our funds from donations. We are financially supported by the Kingman Banks, local businesses, and many generous community individuals. If you are interested in learning more about our program, Sharon will be happy to speak to your organization or to you individually.

Core is helping individuals improve their financial, physical, spiritual, and emotional health. In turn, we feel like this will make Kingman a better place to live for all of us.
